7/05/12/23 TOWN COUNCIL BUDGET REVIEW 2023/24 AND PRECEPT FOR 2024/25

- a. **RESOLVED** that the Annual Budget 2023/24 for the Town Council was reviewed and noted.
- b. **RESOLVED** that the submissions for the annual budget 2024/25 submitted by the individual Town Council Committees be received.
- c. Members prepared the budget proposals for 2024/25 based on the information provided by Town Council Committees, where available. **RESOLVED** that the following amendments would be made compared with the 2023/24 budget.

Income

HDC Grass Cutting - CPI increase from £1,700 to £1,750.

Events from £200 to £500.

Expenditure

Salaries (to reflect the increase in the Living Wage from 10.42 to £11.44 and a 3% increase for Local Government Staff) increase from £95,500 to £101,500.

Additional Staff member to be employed on a zero-hour contract - £5,000.

Stationery – decrease from £500 to £100.

IT Support – increase from £2,100 to £2,500

Insurance – decrease from £4,000 to £3,800

Office Rental - decrease from £6,615 to £6,292

Play Areas – increase from £9,000 to £10,000.

Grass Cutting – CPI increase from £20,000 to £21,000.

Open Spaces – Trees – Decrease from £13,000 to £11,000

Public Toilets – increase from £7,000 to £12,000 to cover the stone repair costs.

S137 Grant - increase from £4,500 to £4,750.

External Audit Costs – increase from £1,000 to £1,200

CCTV – decrease from £1,2000 to £500

Events – decrease from £3,600 to £2,600.

d. Annual Precept 2024/25 – **RESOLVED** that based on the agreed budget for 2024/25 the Precept should be increased by a proposed £8,000 this year from £169,500 to £177,500 (£153,500 Town Council element and £24,000 for the Globe element), a 4.72% increase. Because of the decrease in the Tax base this translates to a 4.93% increase in Council Tax, the equivalent of £3.85 increase for a Band D property.

- a. **RESOLVED** that the Annual Budget 2023/24 for the Town Hall Trust was reviewed and noted.
- b. **RESOLVED** that the Annual Budget 2024/25 for the Town Hall Trust be approved with the following amendments to last year's budget:-

Income

Bar sales – increase from £4,500 to £5,000.

Ticket sales – increase from £8,000 to £10,000.

Expenditure

Laundry – decrease from £2,000 to £1,500.

Cleaning materials – increase from £2,000 to £2,200.

Water - increase from £1,000 to £1,100

Insurance – decrease from £4,600 to £4,000.

PRL and PRS – increase from £450 to £1,000.

Salaries – increase from £43,500 to £47,800 (to cover the increase in Living Wage from £10.42 to £11.44).

Artist Costs – increase from £7,700 to £9,000.

Bar Stock - increase from £2,250 to £2,750.

Professional Fees – increase from £1,000 to £1,050.

Finance Charges – increase from £120 to £200

Marketing / Promotion – to agree the new contract to undertake the marketing and promotion of the Town Hall Events at a cost of £1,500.

Fixtures and Fittings – decrease from £4,000 to £2,000

- c. **RESOLVED** that the Annual Budget for 2023/24 for the Manorial Lands Trust was reviewed and noted.
- d. **RESOLVED** that the Annual Budget 2024/25 for the Manorial Lands Trust be approved with the following amendments to last year's budget:-

Income

Friday Market rents – decrease from £19,000 to £18,000.

Farmers Market rents – decrease from £8,000 to £7,000.

Lease agreements – increase from £3,660 to £3,750 (based on CPI increase of 3%).

Wayleaves – increase from £82 to £100.

Fair Lease – increase from £14,310 to £14,750 (based on a CPI increase of 3%).

Expenditure

Non-domestic rates – increase from nil to £550.

Water rates – decrease from £350 to £300.

Market Cost – increase from £200 to £250.
